ATTACK OF THE GIANT JELLYFISH!

Have you heard about the jellyfish problem? In recent years, a great number of huge jellyfish have been found in the Sea of Japan. These jellyfish have brought many problems to the area.

While the local fishermen *do* net fish, many huge and heavy jellyfish get caught in the fishnets too, causing the nets to break. Repairing these nets is very expensive for the fishermen, and as the huge jellyfish eat so much plankton they cause an imbalance in the marine environment!

There are some who say that the sudden increase in these huge jellyfish is the fault of human beings: fishermen catch too many fish, extra plankton remains, jellyfish have abundant plankton to eat so, become huge. And, they also eat many young fish along with the plankton, reducing the number of fish even more.

Even though some Chinese dishes, even ice-cream makers, use jellyfish, these only consume small quantities; there is no way to make use of so many jellyfish!

But recently there has been some good news concerning jellyfish. The professors at Ehime University and a local food company in Ehime studied the jellyfish together and made some very valuable discoveries: Jelly fish are made up of 95% water, 4% salt and 1% nutrients like nitrogen, phosphorous and collagen. When cut and dried for use as fertilizer, they found that the jellyfish could supplement nitrogen, phosphorous and collagen in the soil, which are necessary for plants to grow. Also, dried jellyfish can absorb 7 times its own weight in water. And, it's biodegradable.



Desertification is now a big problem in the world, and soil is becoming infertile, so the idea is to use jellyfish to make fertilizer. This could not only solve the fishermen's problem, it

could also solve severe desertification problems. They say they expect to use this most inexpensive fertilizer to change the deserts of our world.

A patent for the jellyfish fertilizer has been applied for and they are planning to start experiments next year in Sakurajima, in Kagoshima, and in the forest near Imabari, which was damaged by fire last spring.

I believe this study will turn the useless jellyfish into a useful solution for the desertification of the earth.

Some Thoughts for the Month

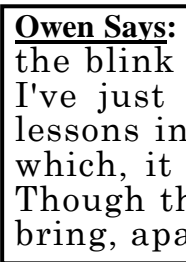

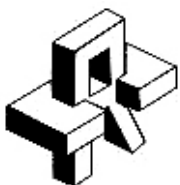
